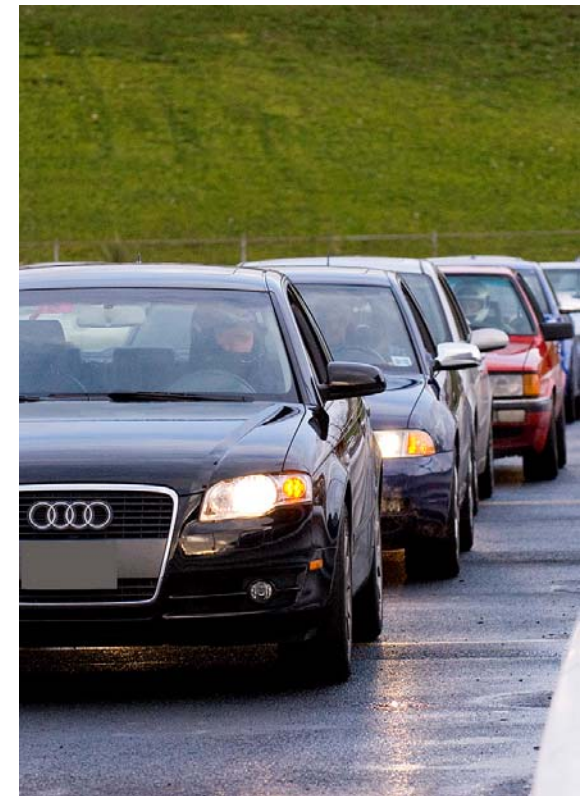

Welcome to Audi Club Northwest!

History

Audi Club Northwest (ACNW) is a regional chapter of Audi Club North America. The club held its first event in 1994 at Portland International Raceway (PIR). Incorporated in 1995, it was originally called the Northwest Region Audi Quattro Club. The club has approximately 500 members across Idaho, Oregon and Washington. ACNW operates as a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation whose purpose is to educate Audi owners about their cars, and enhance their enjoyment of their Audi. We create enthusiasts and better drivers!



Driver's Schools

Skill improvement is the core of Audi Club Northwest. Our schools provide drivers with instruction and practice to avoid dangerous situations. The events are fun and a great place to make new friends.

ACNW offers adult and teen driving clinics with instructors at Portland International Raceway (Portland, OR) and Bremerton Motorsports Park (Bremerton, WA). These clinics are a proper venue to learn your car's limits and enhance your driving skills, thereby increasing your driving fun. Lessons include car dynamics, cornering theory and control. These lessons are then applied in your own car through a series of practical exercises including threshold and emergency braking, cornering, slalom and accident avoidance. If conditions permit the club may offer a winter driving clinic at one of the local mountain passes on snow and ice.

Autocross events are offered in conjunction with the clinics at Bremerton. The driver navigates through the autocross course by following a route of cones that make up turns, gates and slaloms. Since autocross is run at slow speeds it can be timed, with penalties for hitting cones or missing gates. Autocross is an excellent way to practice the car control skills learned in the clinics.

The club hosts lapping events at Portland International Raceway, Bremerton Motorsports Park, and Pacific Raceways (Kent, WA). Using street rules, with strict passing rules enforced, instructed lapping on a road course puts multiple cars on the course for 20-30 minute sessions. This is not racing; there is no side-by-side braking or fender contact. This is another great way to learn and practice car control.



Quattrofest

Quattrofest is the ACNW signature event of the year. It is the entire Audi Club Northwest experience in one event. Held at Portland International Raceway, usually in November, this event includes a driver's clinic and instructed lapping. Quattrofest is also a social event with a banquet on Saturday night. Many members attend from all over the country to see the great northwest and drive at this world-class facility.
